Health inspections underway at construction sites

The HSE is to target construction firms across Great Britain over their health standards.

HSE has announced that these inspections will be the first time the regulator has targeted the industry with a specific focus on respiratory risks and occupational lung disease. Inspectors will be looking at the measures businesses have in place to protect their workers' lungs from the likes of asbestos, silica and wood dust.

Throughout October inspectors will be visiting construction businesses and sites across the country and will specifically be looking for evidence of construction workers knowing the risks, planning their work and using the right controls. Enforcement will be used if necessary to ensure people are protected.
