June 2019 changes to the CITB Health, Safety & Environment test

On 26th June 2019 there will be changes to make the CITB Health, Safety and Environment (HS&E) test even more robust, so that operatives can continue to be safe on the job, and know that their fellow workers are just as qualified to contribute to a safe working environment.

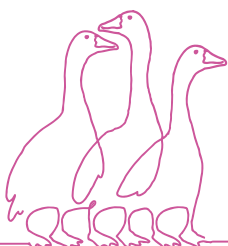
All versions of the test have been reviewed to ensure that the revised HS&E test is up-to-date and fit for the needs of workers and employers.

The test will now consist of 50 questions based over one section only, with the behavioural case studies section now being omitted, and the pass mark will be 45 out of 50 for Operatives and Specialists tests and 46 out of 50 for Managers and Professionals tests. The questions will remain the same proportion of easy, medium and hard questions served up randomly to each candidate.
